RESOLUTION OF TOWN BOARD
TO IMPOSE MANDATORY
RESTRICTIONS ON NONESSENTIAL
OUTDOOR WATER USE DUE TO
DROUGHT CONDITIONS
PURSUANT TO MUNICIPAL CODE
SECTION 179-40

Councilman LoBiondo presented the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Manley.

WHEREAS, due to the recent prolonged absence of substantial rainfall, the Town Board finds it in the best interests of the Town of Newburgh and the public health, safety and welfare to impose mandatory restrictions on nonessential outdoor use of water provided by the Town of Newburgh Consolidated Water District pursuant to the authority reserved to the Town under Municipal Code Section 179-40.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that we the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh hereby temporarily prohibits the following nonessential outdoor uses of water supplied by the Town of Newburgh Consolidated Water District :

- the irrigation of lawns/gardens via sprinklers or automatic irrigation systems (commercial nurseries, landscaping and plant centers and other commercial water users engaged in the business of growing, distributing or selling plants, shrubs or trees are excluded);
- the filling of residential swimming pools/ hot tubs;
- the washing of vehicles except by bucket (the operation of commercial automatic and "do it yourself" car washes is excluded);
- the washing of exterior building surfaces, driveways and walkways;
- the filling of artificial or ornamental displays such as fountains, waterfalls, reflecting pools, and ponds,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that these restrictions shall take effect immediately and remain in place until the Supervisor notifies the public that they are no longer warranted.
