WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh adopted a resolution on the 27th day of September, 2022 introducing and ordering a public hearing to be held on the 11th day of October, 2022 at 7:00 o'clock p.m., prevailing time, to hear all interested parties on proposed Local Law No. ___ of the Year 2022 entitled "A Local Law Amending Sections 166-5 and 166-19 of Chapter 166 entitled "Taxation" of the Code of the Town of Newburgh: Exemptions of Persons 65 Years and Over and For Persons with a Disability"; and

WHEREAS, a notice of Public Hearing was duly advertised on the ___rd day of October, 2022 in The Mid-Hudson Times and posted on the Town Clerk's sign board on the ___nd day of October, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearing was duly held on the 11th day of October, 2022 at 7:00 o'clock p.m., at Town Hall, 1496 Route 300, Newburgh, New York and all parties in attendance were permitted to speak on behalf or in opposition of the proposed Local Law or any part thereof; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of said Local Law raising the real property assessment exemption levels for persons 65 years and over and for persons with disabilities constitutes a legislative action pertaining to routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment, and accordingly is a Type II Action under the State Environmental Quality Review Act; and

WHEREAS, due to the introduction or adoption of intervening local laws, said Local Law shall be designated as Town of Newburgh Local Law No. ___ of the Year 2022 upon filing; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh, after due deliberation finds it in the best interest of the Town to adopt said Local Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The Town Board of the Town of Newburgh hereby adopts said Local Law #__ of 2022 entitled "A Local Law Amending Sections 166-5 and 166-19 of Chapter 166 entitled "Taxation" of the Code of the Town of Newburgh: Exemptions of Persons 65 Years and Over and For Persons with a Disability".
2. The Town Clerk is hereby directed to enter this resolution and said Local Law in the minutes of this meeting and the Local Law Book of the Town of Newburgh and to give due notice of the adoption of said Local Law to the Secretary of State and to the public.

**INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW NO. ___ OF THE YEAR 2022
AMENDING SECTIONS 166-5 AND 166-19
OF CHAPTER 166 ENTITLED "TAXATION"
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH:
EXEMPTIONS FOR PERSONS SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OVER
AND FOR PERSONS WITH A DISABILITY**

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh as follows:

SECTION 1 - TITLE

This Local Law shall be referred to as "A Local Law Amending Sections 166-5 and 166-19 of Chapter 166 entitled 'Taxation' of the Municipal Code of the Town of Newburgh: Exemptions for Persons Sixty-Five Years of Age or Over and for Persons with a Disability".

SECTION 2 - AMENDMENT TO SECTION 166-5

Section 166-5 "Exemption Granted" of Chapter 166 entitled "Taxation" of the Code of the Town of Newburgh is hereby amended to read as follows:

"§ 166-5. Exemption granted.

Real property in the Town of Newburgh owned by one or more persons, each of whom is 65 years of age or more, or real property owned by husband and wife, one of whom is 65 years of age or over, or by siblings, one of whom is 65 years of age or over, shall, depending on the annual income of said persons, be exempt from taxation by the town to the extent of the percentage of the assessed valuation thereof set forth in the following Schedule of Exemptions.

Schedule of Exemptions

Annual Income	Percentage of Assessed Valuation Exempt From Taxation
\$50,000.00 or less	50%
\$5,0001.00 to \$50,999.00	45%
\$51,000.00 to \$51,999.00	40%
\$52,000.00 to \$52,999.00	35%
\$53,000.00 to \$53,899.00	30%

\$53,900.00 to \$54,799.00	25%
\$54,800.00 to \$55,699.00	20%
\$55,700.00 to \$56,599.00	15%
\$56,600.00 to \$57,499.00	10%
\$57,500.00 to \$58,399.00	5%

SECTION 3 – AMENDMENT TO SECTION 166-19

Section 166-19 "Exemption Granted" of Chapter 166 entitled "Taxation" of the Code of the Town of Newburgh is hereby amended to read as follows:

"§ 166-19. Exemption granted.

Real property owned by one or more persons with disabilities, or real property owned by a husband, wife or both, or by siblings, at least one of whom has a disability and whose income is limited by reason of such disability, shall be exempt from taxation by the town to the extent of the percentage of the assessed valuation thereof set forth in the following schedule of exemptions. (Note: Pursuant to the powers given to a municipal corporation in Real Property Tax Law § 459-c(1)(b), the figure represented herein as "(M)" shall be \$50,000.00 in the Town of Newburgh.)

Schedule of Exemptions

Annual Income	Percentage Assessed Valuation Exempt From Taxation
(M) or less	50%
More than (M) but less than (M) plus \$1,000	45%
(M) plus \$1,000 or more but less than (M) plus \$2,000	40%
(M) plus \$2,000 or more but less than (M) plus \$3,000	35%
(M) plus \$3,000 or more) but less than (M) plus \$3,900	30%
(M) plus \$3,900 or more but less than (M) plus \$4,800	25%

(M) + \$4,800 or more but less than (M) plus \$5,700	20%
(M) \$5,700 or more but less than (M) plus \$6,600	15%
(M) plus \$6,600 or more but less than (M) plus \$7,500	10%
(M) + \$7,500 or more but less than (M) plus \$8,400"	5%

SECTION 4 - NO RETROACTIVE EFFECT

The annual income limits for exemptions for persons 65 years and older and persons with a disability which are increased by the amendments contained in Sections 2 and 3 above shall apply to assessed valuations for the March 1, 2023 taxable status date and thereafter. The amendment shall not apply retroactively.

SECTION 5 - VALIDITY

The invalidity of any provision of this Local Law shall not affect the validity of any other provision of this Local Law that can be given effect without such invalid provision.

SECTION 6 - EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately when it is filed in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
