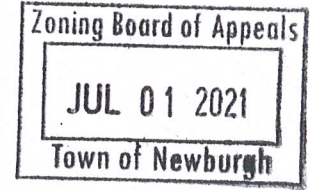

The two dwelling units pre-date the zoning laws as does the existing shed.
