BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Clerk give notice of such public hearing by the publication of a notice in the official newspapers of the Town, specifying the time when and the place where such public hearing will be held at least three (3) days prior to the public hearing in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Home Rule Law and Section 25-1 of the Town of Newburgh Municipal Code and by posting one copy of the local law together with the notice of hearing on the signboard of his office not later than the day such notice is published; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of the aforesaid local law and notice of the public hearing be forwarded to all municipalities, agencies and boards required to receive such copies and notices in accordance with the provisions of the New York State General Municipal Law, the New York State Town Law and the Town of Newburgh Zoning Code.

**INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW # __ OF 2014
A LOCAL LAW AMENDING SECTION 185-55 ENTITLED "PROCEDURES;
CONSTRUAL OF PROVISIONS; CONFLICT WITH STATE LAW"
OF ARTICLE VIII ENTITLED "BOARD OF APPEALS" OF
CHAPTER 185 ENTITLED "ZONING"
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH:
FEES FOR INTERPRETATION APPLICATIONS**

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh as follows:

SECTION 1 - TITLE

This Local Law shall be referred to as "A Local Law Amending Section 185-55 Entitled 'Procedures; construal of provisions; conflict with state law' of Article VIII Entitled 'Board of Appeals' of Chapter 185 entitled 'Zoning' of the Code of the Town of Newburgh: Fees for Interpretation Applications".

SECTION 2 – PURPOSE

The purpose of this local law is to reconcile a discrepancy between Chapter 104 Entitled "Schedule of Fees" which provides for a fee for interpretation applications to the Zoning Board of Appeals and the Zoning Code, which provides that no fee shall be required for interpretation applications and to clarify that applications and requests by an official, board or agency of the Town are not subject to a fee.

SECTION 3 - AMENDMENT TO SECTION 185-55 OF ARTICLE VIII OF CHAPTER 185

Subsection 185-55E entitled "Forms and fees" of Section 185-55 entitled "Procedures; construal of provisions; conflict with state law" of Article VIII entitled "Board of Appeals" of Chapter 185 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"E. Forms and fees. All appeals and applications made to the Zoning Board of Appeals shall be in writing, on forms prescribed by the Board, and shall be accompanied by a fee as prescribed by Chapter 104, Fees of this Code. However, no fee shall be required for applications requesting an interpretation as provided in § 185-54A of this Chapter. Fees shall not apply to applications and requests made to the Zoning Board of Appeals by an official, board or agency of the town."

SECTION 4 – VALIDITY

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid,

such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

SECTION 5 - EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately when it is filed in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

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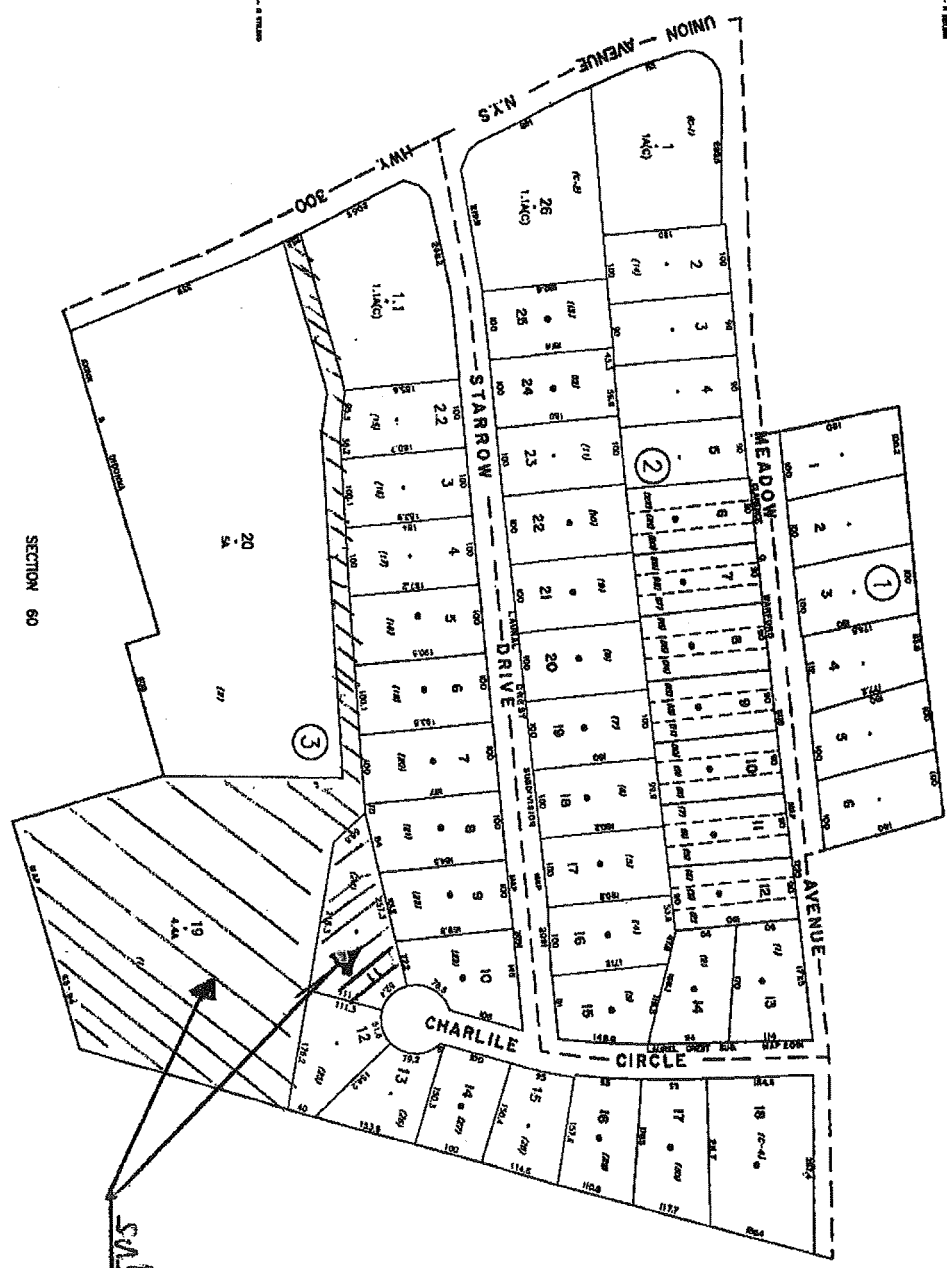
LEGEND

Enclosed please find the proposed Stipulation of Settlement and Order in reference to the above-referenced proceedings. The subject properties are a vacant commercial parcel on Union Avenue and a vacant residential parcel on Charlie Circle. The residential parcel is not being reduced. The commercial parcel is being reduced from an assessed value of \$214,500 to \$112,500. This settlement was negotiated after John Venezia reviewed the subject parcels and took into account the actual available buildable area of the commercial parcel and the cost of further litigation to the Town. John and I feel that this is a good settlement.

We recommend that the Town Board authorize us to enter into this settlement as proposed. Please place this matter on the agenda for the next Newburgh Town Board Meeting for approval. Please advise me once the Resolution passes and I will sign the original Stipulation of Settlement and forward it to the petitioner's attorney for filing.


I have enclosed for your review a copy of the refund liability charts which show the potential liability and the proposed settlement.

STIPULATED AND AGREED that the order provide, that the Town of Newburgh, shall audit and allow the claim of the petitioner for the overpayment of the Town taxes paid by petitioner for the above assessment years in excess of what the taxes would have been if the assessments had been made upon the reduced assessed valuations as ordered, with interest pursuant to statute, except in the event that the refund of taxes is paid within 60 days from the date of service of a certified copy of Court Order with Notice of Entry, then interest is waived, and it is further

STIPULATED AND AGREED that the order provide that the Newburgh City School District shall audit and allow the claim of petitioner for overpayment of the School taxes paid by petitioner for the above assessment years in excess of what the taxes would have been if the assessments made upon the reduced assessed valuation as

ordered, with interest pursuant to statute, except in the event that the refund of taxes is paid within 60 days from the date of service of a certified copy of Court Order with Notice of Entry, then interest is waived, and it is further

STIPULATED AND AGREED, that the order provide that the Commissioner of Finance, on behalf of the County Legislator of the County of Orange, shall audit and allow the claim of the petitioner for the overpayment of County and all special district taxes and assessments paid by petitioner for the above assessment years in excess of what the taxes would have been if the assessments had been made upon the reduced assessed valuations as ordered, with interest pursuant to statute, except in the event that the refund of taxes is paid within 60 days from the date of service of a certified copy of Court Order with Notice of Entry, then interest is waived, and it is further

STIPULATED AND AGREED that to the extent any taxes or assessments are unpaid and have already been billed for the Town, School, County and special districts in accordance with the original assessed valuations, the officer or officers having custody of the assessment rolls and/or the tax rolls shall forward to the petitioner, in care of KOEPPPEL MARTONE & LEISTMAN, LLP, as attorneys, a new bill or bills, taxing said petitioner on the basis of the final total assessed valuations as stipulated herein, and it is further

STIPULATED AND AGREED that the within stipulation constitutes a full settlement of these tax certiorari proceedings for the 2012 and 2013 assessment rolls of the Town of Newburgh, and that upon

compliance with the terms of this stipulation, the proceedings shall be deemed discontinued, with prejudice, and without costs or allowances to any party.

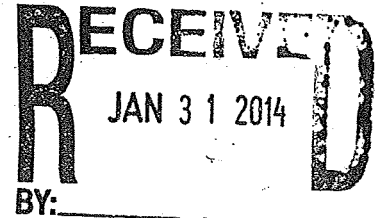
