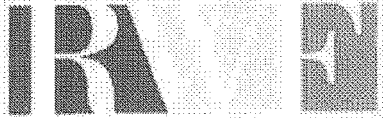

On 3 August 2021 the Town received bids for painting 300 hydrants with an option for an additional 200 if authorized.

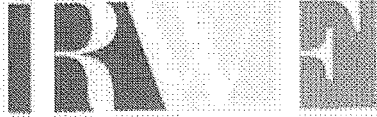

Dear Supervisor Piaquadio,

On 3 June 2021 the subject project received conditional final approval from the Planning Board. The approval contained six (6) specific conditions which must be addressed prior to the Planning Board signing the plans:

Condition #2 – Sidewalk Installation, identified “The applicant shall obtain conceptual approval and authorization from the NYSDOT for installation of a sidewalk along NYS Route 300. The applicant shall obtain a Highway Work Permit for such work and complete the installation of the sidewalks within one (1) year following the full operation of the project in accordance with the terms of the Host Community Benefit Agreement for this project. The applicant shall post, with the Town Clerk, a performance security in an amount recommend by the Town Engineer in order to secure timely completion and appropriate maintenance of the sidewalk improvements satisfactory to the Town Board, Town Engineer and Town Attorney as to form, sufficiency, manner of execution and surety. The Bond shall recite that all improvements secured thereby shall be completed within one (1) year following full project operation.”

The applicant’s Engineer, JMC Engineering has provided a cost estimate based on plans last revised 22 June 2021 for the work for the sidewalk along NYS Route 300 and the site driveway. The cost estimate identifies a total of \$43,697.50 say \$43,700.

Approval of the security requires Town Board action. We are requesting the Town Board accept the cost estimate in the amount of \$43,700. Upon Town Board approval of the security amount, the applicants will provide appropriate security as acceptable to the Town Attorney.
