Attached for the Town Board's consideration following the close of the public hearing scheduled for September 9, 2019 is the following draft Order:

PUBLIC INTEREST ORDER IN THE MATTER OF THE INCREASE AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE FACILITIES OF THE CROSSROADS CONSOLIDATED SEWER DISTRICT IN THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH, ORANGE COUNTY, NEW YORK

A copy of Addendum No. 1 to the original Engineering Report addressing the \$204,000 project cost increase from \$1,160,000 to \$1,364,000 prepared by the project engineers, GHD, for this supplemental Town Law Section 202-b proceeding was forwarded with the Public Hearing Order. The proceedings are required in order to authorize the additional funding. The original Town Law Section 202-b proceedings, including a public hearing, were conducted by the Town Board in 2014. The project is being undertaken at the instance of the NYS DEC and following the project's approval, certain investigations were performed and alternatives explored to address the issues of concern with the sewer system.

As we previously reminded the Board, the Meadow Hill South Sewer District was part of the sewer district consolidation undertaken in 2016. Under the terms of the approved Joint Consolidation Agreement, the additional \$206,000 in costs will be borne by the whole Crossroads Consolidated Sewer District, while the original \$1,160,000 will still be borne by the property owners in the benefit area of the consolidated district that was formerly the Meadow Hill South Sewer District.

WHEREAS, pursuant to proceedings heretofore had and taken by the Town Board of the
Town of Newburgh, Orange County, New York, pursuant to the provisions of Section 202-b of the
Town Law, it has been determined to be in the public interest to provide for a certain increase and
improvement of the Facilities of the former Meadow Hill South Sewer District of the Town of
Newburgh, Orange County, New York, at a maximum estimated cost of \$1,160,000; and

WHEREAS, such increase and improvement of facilities includes the construction of a
replacement relief sewer from the comminator building at Saddle Place to Union Avenue, including,
original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances, and incidental improvements
and expenses in connection therewith, at said maximum estimated cost of \$1,160,000; and

WHEREAS, said capital project has been determined to be an Unlisted Action pursuant to
the regulations of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation promulgated
pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), the implementation of which
as proposed, it has been determined will not result in a significant environmental effect and the

documentation relating to SEQRA is available in the office of the Town Clerk for inspection during normal office hours; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to proceedings heretofore had and taken by the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh, Orange County, New York pursuant to the provisions of Section 751 of the General Municipal Law, the Meadow Hill South Sewer District has been consolidated with the Crossroads Consolidated Sewer District, the Wintergreen Sewer District, the Fleetwood-Holiday Park Sewer District, the 17K/UA Sewer District, the Meadow Hill North Sewer District, the Gidney Sewer District and the Algonquin Sewer District into a single sewer district known as the Crossroads Consolidated Sewer District in accordance with the terms and conditions of the certain JOINT CONSOLIDATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CROSSROADS CONSOLIDATED SEWER DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH, NEW YORK AND THE WINTERGREEN SEWER DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH, NEW YORK AND THE FLEETWOOD-HOLIDAY PARK SEWER DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH, NEW YORK AND THE 17K/UNION AVENUE SEWER DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH, NEW YORK AND THE MEADOW HILL NORTH SEWER DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH, NEW YORK AND THE MEADOW HILL SOUTH SEWER DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH, NEW YORK AND THE GIDNEY SEWER DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH, NEW YORK AND THE ALGONQUIN SEWER DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH, NEW YORK PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 17-A OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK dated November 8, 2016 (the "Joint Consolidation Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Joint Consolidation Agreement provides that future improvements of the Consolidated Crossroads Sewer District which are financed will be paid for by indebtedness of the consolidated district assessed and paid for on a benefit basis by all property owners and users of the Crossroads Consolidated Sewer District; and

WHEREAS, in order to complete the aforesaid improvements, it will be necessary to expend the sum of \$1,364,000, an increase of \$204,000 over that previously authorized; and

WHEREAS, by order dated August 12, 2019, the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh called a public hearing on said increase and improvement of the facilities of said Crossroads Consolidated Sewer District at a new maximum estimated cost of \$1,364,000, an increase of \$204,000 over that previously authorized, and to hear all persons interested in the subject thereof, concerning the same, in accordance with the provisions of Section 202-b of the Town Law; and

WHEREAS, such increase in maximum estimated cost shall be levied and collected from the several lots and parcels of land in the Crossroads Consolidated Sewer District deemed benefited thereby by said Town Board as much upon and from each as shall be in just proportion to the amount of benefit which such improvement shall confer upon the same; and

WHEREAS, notice of said public hearing was duly published and posted in the manner and within the time provided by law and such public hearing as duly held at which all persons interested in the subject matter thereof were duly heard; and

WHEREAS, said Town Board has duly considered the evidence given at said public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED, by the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh, Orange County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Upon the evidence given at the aforesaid public hearing, it is hereby found and determined that it is in the public interest to make the improvements to the facilities of the Crossroads Consolidated Sewer District, to wit: the construction of a replacement relief sewer from the comminutor building at Saddle Place to Union Avenue, including, original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances, and incidental improvements and expenses in connection therewith, at a new maximum estimated cost of \$1,364,000, an increase of \$204,000 over that previously authorized, to be apportioned in accordance with the Joint Consolidation Agreement and the apportioned amounts to be levied and collected from the several lots and parcels of land in the Crossroads Consolidated Sewer District in the manner provided by law.

Section 2. This Order shall take effect immediately.

The question of the adoption of the foregoing order was duly put to a vote on roll call, which resulted as follows:

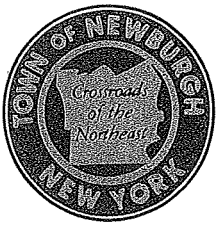

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH IN SUPPORT OF UPGRADING ROUTE 17 IN ORANGE AND SULLIVAN COUNTIES

Councilman/woman _____ presented the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman/woman _____.

WHEREAS, the Mid-Hudson Region is achieving economic and population growth due to its proximity to New York City and other states as well as being home to attractive communities with a high quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the Region has an immediate requirement for infrastructure investments to allow economic development to continue and maintain the Region's ability to attract jobs and preserve its quality of life for its citizens; and

WHEREAS, in May of 2013, the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) issued a study (The Route 17 Transportation Corridor Study) that recommended a new General Use Third Lane be developed along the Route 17 Corridor and found that

"additional transportation capacity is needed to address existing and projected levels of congestion in the corridor, provide for enhanced mobility, and allow for future economic growth in both Sullivan and Orange Counties"

; and

WHEREAS, while the improvements underway at Interchange 131 near Woodbury Common, and the proposed improvements to accommodate LEGOLAND are welcome and necessary, they will not address the existing and worsening traffic issues along the Corridor; and

WHEREAS, investments along the Route 17 Corridor are consistent with smart growth principles and the 2011 report issued by the Open Space Institute (Private Lands, Public Benefits) which found that Sullivan County has the greatest percentage of preferred growth area in the Catskills, "which is largely concentrated in the center of the county and coincides with significant, established infrastructure"; and

WHEREAS, the full conversion of Route 17 to interstate standards (I-86) was previously scheduled to be completed by 2009, but that has not occurred in many of the eastern sections of Route 17 and major upgrades to Route 17 need to be implemented to meet interstate standards; and

WHEREAS, as part of the 2018-19 New York State Budget, the New York State Department of Transportation has committed to "provide up to \$5 million to advance environmental and design activities related to the construction of a third travel lane along the Route 17 Corridor in Orange and Sullivan Counties"; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Transportation recently selected a

consultant to conduct a Planning and Environmental Linkage Study (PEL) as the next step in the process leading to the implementation of the recommendations from the Corridor Study, providing locations of priority and conducting environmental assessments and preliminary engineering; and

WHEREAS, the current estimate of the cost of implementing the Corridor Study is approximately \$500 million; and

WHEREAS, the Mid-Hudson Valley Region needs to continue to grow and attract businesses and jobs, and the 2013 NYSDOT Study has documented the requirements of the Route 17 Corridor.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby **RESOLVED**, that we, the **Town Board of the Town of Newburgh** strongly support efforts to improve the Route 17 Corridor and encourages the New York State Department of Transportation to begin as soon as possible the environmental processes necessary to advance the construction of a third lane along the Route 17 Corridor consistent with interstate standards; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$500 million in Capital Funding to make these important investments along the Route 17 Corridor be included in the State's and Nation's Infrastructure Programs so that the necessary projects to modernize Route 17 can commence as soon as possible.
