



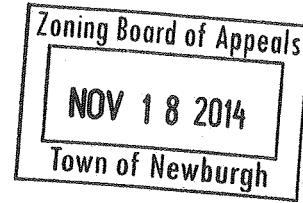

I am on receipt of your letter dated October 17, 2014 regarding the application from Martin Milano proposing to build a hotel and restaurant at 1 Crossroads Court (On Route 17K – Adjacent to I-87), Newburgh, NY. This location is in the proximity of Stewart International Airport (SWF)


In order for the Federal Aviation Administration to evaluate the possible impact to navigable airspace, including impact to Stewart International Airport, the proponent needs to file with the FAA Form 7460-1. Filing can be done electronically by going to:  
<https://oeaaa.faa.gov/oeaaa/external/portal.jsp>

The proponent must register to get his username/password and then complete the electronic 7460 Form. I recommend completing one form (latitude/longitude/site elevation and structure height) per building corner and any light poles included in the project.

The FAA will evaluate the proposal and respond to the proponent if the proposed project results in any hazard to air navigation.
