NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE TOWN ENGINEER HAS REVIEWED THE PLANS FOR THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW 20' X 30' CONCRETE DRIVEWAY AT THE INTERSECTION OF STATE ST. AND 100 N. STATE ST., NEWBURGH, NY. THE PLANS WERE SUBMITTED TO THE TOWN ENGINEER ON 08/15/2011. THE TOWN ENGINEER HAS REVIEWED THE PLANS AND HAS DETERMINED THAT THE PLANS COMPLY WITH THE TOWN ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT'S REQUIREMENTS FOR A DRIVEWAY. THE TOWN ENGINEER HAS ISSUED A PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT FOR THE DRIVEWAY. THE PERMIT IS VALID FOR 180 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUANCE.
