additional time.

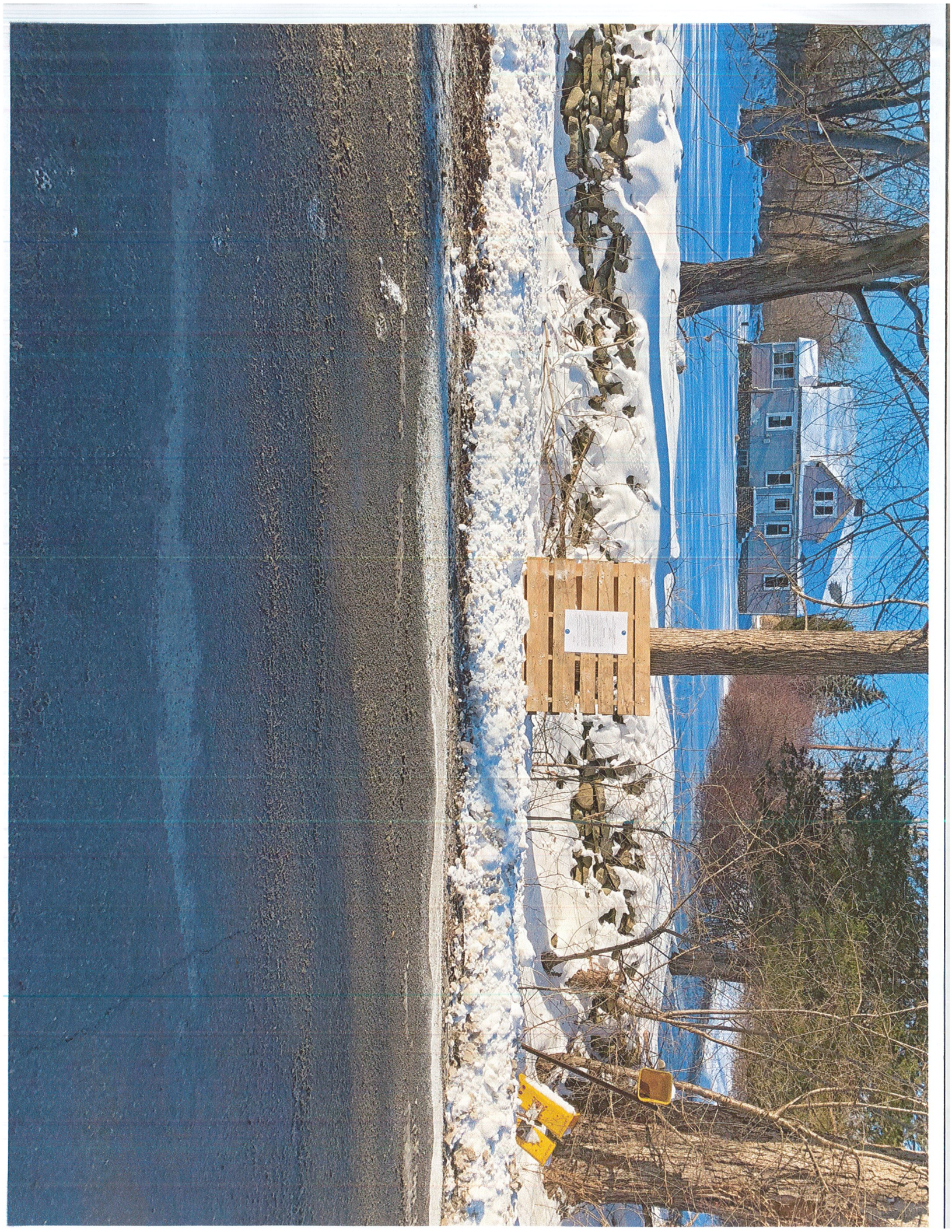

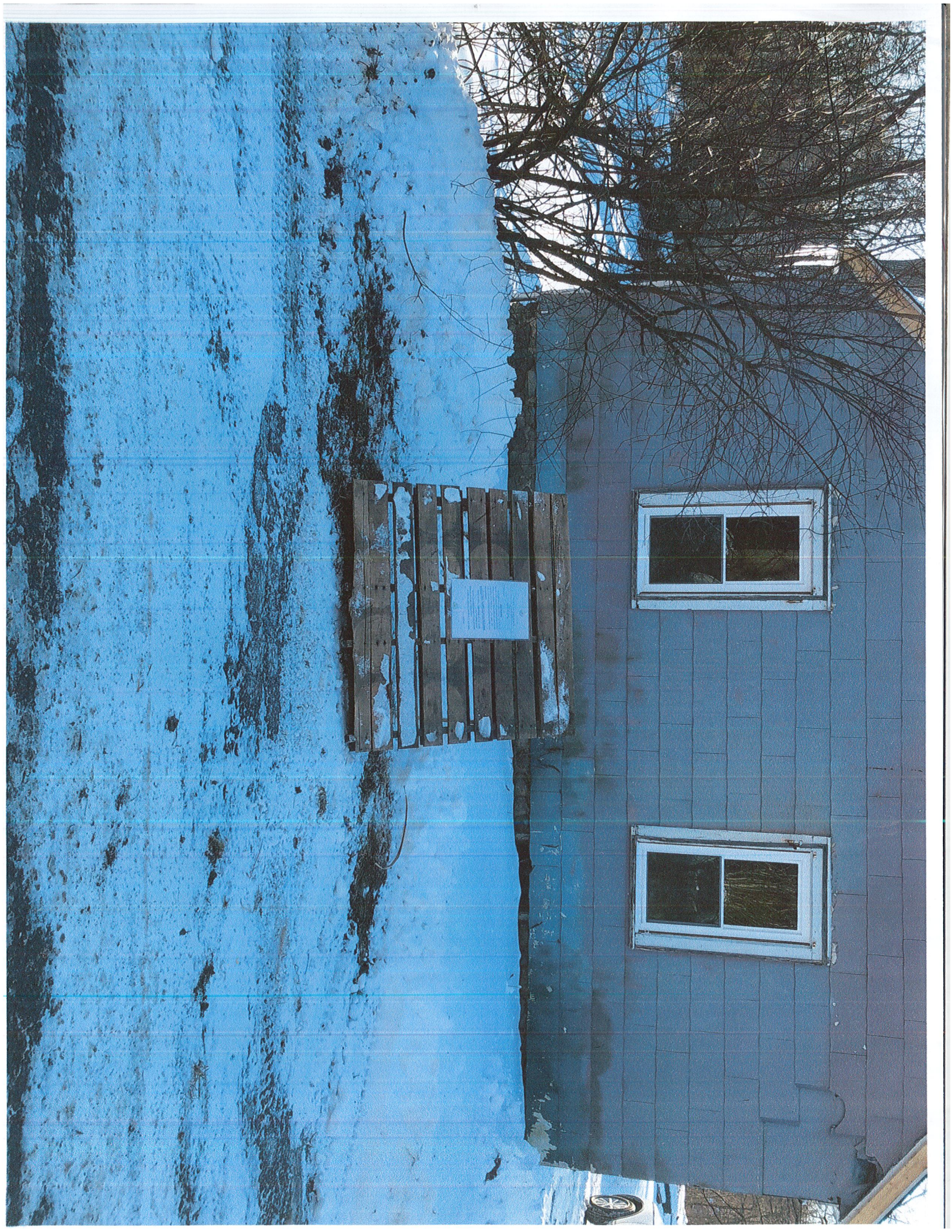
