Comments:

County Planning is in receipt of the GML §239 referral for the above referenced Project. Based upon our review of the submitted materials, our office has found no evidence that significant inter-municipal or county-wide impacts would result from its approval. County Planning recommends that the Board make a decision only after ensuring the Applicant has adequately demonstrated to the Board an unnecessary hardship. Our office would like to include the following as advisory comments:

1. County Planning recommends the Board determine if the Applicant needs to receive Planning Board approval related to the solar array. In the event Planning Board approval is not necessary and although the Solar array is being proposed in the side yard of the residence, our office recommends that the board determine if screening is warranted to minimize visual impacts to adjoining properties without impacting the collection of solar energy.
